

PURPOSE AND CONTENTS OF THIS MAP


The designation shown on this motor vehicle travel map (MVTM) were made by the responsible official pursuant to 36 CFR 212.51, and will remain in effect until superseded by the next year's MVTM.

It is the responsibility of the user to acquire the current travel information. This MVTM is not the official Motor Vehicle Use Map (MUM), yet it shows the National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and the areas on National Forest System lands in the South Plate Ranger District that are designated for motor vehicle use pursuant to 36 CFR 212.51. This MVTM also identifies the vehicle classes allowed on each route and in each area, and any seasonal restrictions that apply on those routes and in those areas. In addition to showing everything that is on the MUM, this MVTM also shows BLM lands and State lands outside the forest boundary, plus other information to help navigate on the forest.

This motor vehicle travel map identifies those roads, trails, and areas designated for motor vehicle use under 36 CFR 212.51 for the purpose of enforcing the prohibition at 36 CFR 261.13. This is a limited purpose. The other public roads are shown for information and navigation purposes only and are not subject to designation under the Forest Service travel management regulation.

These designations apply only to National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and areas on National Forest System lands.

PROHIBITIONS

It is prohibited to possess or operate a motor vehicle on National Forest System lands in the South Plate Ranger District other than in accordance with these designations (36 CFR 261.13)

Violators of 36 CFR 261.13 are subject to a fine of up to \$5,000, imprisonment for up to 6 months, or both (18 U.S.C. 3571(e)).

This map does not display nonmotorized uses, over-snow vehicle uses, or other facilities and attractions on the South Plate Ranger District.

Designated roads, trails and areas may also be subject to temporary, emergency closures. As a visitor, you must comply with signs notifying you of such restrictions.

The designation "road or trail open to all motor vehicles" does not supersede State traffic law.

OPERATOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Operating a motor vehicle on National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and in areas on National Forest System lands carries a greater responsibility than operating that vehicle in a city or other developed setting.

Motor vehicle use, especially off-highway vehicle use, involves inherent risks that may cause property damage, serious injury, and possibly death to participants.

Much of the South Plate Ranger District is remote. Medical assistance may not be readily available. Cellular telephones do not work in many areas of the South Plate Ranger District.

ALWAYS REMEMBER TO RESPECT PRIVATE LAND! PROTECT YOUR PRIVILEGE. STAY ON DESIGNATED ROADS AND TRAILS AND IN DESIGNATED AREAS.



EXPLANATION OF LEGEND ITEMS

Legal Vehicles Only:

- r: vehicles licensed under State law for general operation on all public roads.
- 955: vehicles, including smaller off highway vehicles that may not be licensed for highway use or light vehicles under State traffic law.
- 5: vehicles, including both highway legal and nonhighway legal vehicles.
- 0' or Less in Width: vehicles less than 50 inches in width at the widest point on the vehicle.
- 10' is Only: bicycles. Sidecars are not permitted.
- 10': road or trail is open to classes of vehicles other than those listed above. Refer to the Vehicle Designations Table for further instructions.

Trails:

- ways, U.S., State, County & Other Public Roads
- Designated for motorized use by the Forest Service. Part of the reference layers showing facilities outside the forest boundary.

Notes that are too short to show a symbol type on the map. The symbol contains the trail number. Users should refer to the corresponding number in the Short Route Table for further instructions.

Map Revisions

The designations shown on this map will remain in effect until revised with the publication of a new map. In January of each year, this motor vehicle travel map will either be revised with the publication of a new map, or it will be validated for the new year by the Ranger District with a red stamp that says "Valid to Year 20__".

Parking/Dispersed Camping On The Pike National Forest

- Where designated parking areas are not available, and where not specifically prohibited, unsafe, or causing resource damage, parking on National Forest System lands within one vehicle length off of designated routes is authorized.
- Dispersed camping is authorized on National Forest System lands except in specially designated areas that are closed to camping.
- Motorized dispersed camping is authorized within one vehicle length off of designated National Forest System routes, where not specifically prohibited, unsafe, or causing resource damage.
- Check with the local National Forest District office for current information on areas closed to camping and for other travel management information.

Temporary Closures

- Check with www.fs.usda.gov/psic, Alerts and Notices tab, for current temporary closures and prohibitions.
- See Forest Order PSICC-2017-11 for camping and/or parking restrictions on and within 1/4 mile of National Forest System roads in the South Platte Ranger District. This Order only allows camping and/or parking in the Restricted Area where posted with these symbols:

Campground Information

- Most South Platte Ranger District developed recreation sites and access roads are closed during the winter months.
